The Purple Star School designation is approved at the state level and reflects the schools and districts who have demonstrated prioritization of readiness to support the social-emototional challenges military-connected students face.

What does my school or district need to do to achieve the Purple Star School designation?

Each state has a specific designation granting body and application process. The program is still expanding nationally, so states are all in different stages of legislation and implementation. While MCEC does not designate Purple Star Schools, we are the National Advocate for the program and focus on education and readiness for schools seeking the designation through their state.

Step 1:
